

Après-Coup Formation Program Course Equivalencies

The Après-Coup Formation Program includes four general areas of study:

1. Psychoanalytic Theory
2. Psychopathology and Diagnosis
3. Socio-Cultural Dimensions of Subjectivity
4. Clinical Practice, Research, Technique, and Ethics

It is expected that a Student (Analysand in Formation, AF) complete ten credits in each of these areas in order to complete the educational phase of the program, plus four credits in reading groups and four credits in cartels. The total number of credits required to complete the Formation Program is 48.

According to the requirements for licensure in the State of New York, an applicant must complete 45 clock hours in each of the following nine areas of curriculum. Please note that letters following each Après-Coup area of study under Course Equivalencies indicate how each event in that category may be applied with respect to these requirements.

- a. Subject's Structure (Personality Development);
- b. Psychoanalytic theory of psychopathology;
- c. Psychoanalytic theory of psycho diagnosis;
- d. Sociocultural influence on growth and psychopathology;
- e. Practice technique (including dreams and symbolic processes);
- f. Analysis of resistance, transference, & countertransference;
- g. Case seminars on clinical practice;
- h. Practice in psychopathology and psychodiagnosis;
- i. Professional ethics and psychoanalytic research methodology.
